



Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

Stand: While the presider enters and approaches the Tabernacle.

Kneel: When the presider opens the Tabernacle doors.

The presider places the Luna with the Blessed Sacrament into the monstrance on the altar and moves to his place in front of the altar.

Once the presider begins to incense the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance all will sing the Salutaris.

O Salutaris

O salutaris Hostia
Quae coeli pandis ostium:
Bella premunt hostilia,
Da robur, fer auxilium

Uni trinoque Domino
Sit sempiterna gloria,
Qui vitam sine termino
Nobis donet in patria. Amen.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Kneel: The presider and altar server(s) will go to their assigned place to start the private portion of the adoration/devotion.

Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament

Kneel: Once the individual, private adoration/devotion is completed for the hour, the presider incenses the monstrance, all sing the *Tantum Ergo*:

Tantum Ergo

Tantum ergo Sacramentum
Veneremur cernui:
Et antiquum documentum
Novo cedat ritui
Praestet fides supplementum
Sensuum defectui.

Genitori, Genitoque
Laus et jubilatio
Salus, honor, virtus quoque
Sit et benedictio:
Procedenti ab utroque
Compar sit laudatio. Amen.

Benediction Prayer:

Presider: You have given them Bread from Heaven.

All: Containing in itself all delight.

Presider: Let us pray. Lord Jesus Christ, you gave us the Eucharist as the memorial of your suffering and death. May our worship of this sacrament of your body and blood help us to experience the salvation you won for us and the peace of the kingdom where you live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. **All:** Amen

All remain *kneeling* while the Presider elevates the monstrance during Benediction.

The Divine Praises

Blessed be God.

Blessed be his Holy Name.

Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true Man.

Blessed be the Name of Jesus.

Blessed be his most Sacred Heart.

Blessed be his most Precious Blood.

Blessed be Jesus in the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar.

Blessed be the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete.

Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most holy.

Blessed be her holy and Immaculate Conception.

Blessed be her glorious Assumption.

Blessed be the name of Mary, virgin and mother.

Blessed be St. Joseph, her most chaste spouse.

Blessed be God in his Angels and in his Saints.

All: May the Heart of Jesus in the most Blessed Sacrament be praised, adored and loved with grateful affection at every moment, in all tabernacles of the world, now and until the end of time. Amen.

Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament

Remain *kneeling* while the presider reposes the Luna with the Blessed Sacrament into the Tabernacle.

Stand After the presider has closed the Tabernacle doors, begin singing Holy God We Praise Thy Name.
